

# JBCYC - Safe Sailing in a Nutshell

*Short dot point outline of procedures. Detailed explanations on club web site should be referred to.*

1. **Get In – Sail – Get Out**
2. **Read & be familiar** with all Covid-19 documentation on the JBCYC web site.
3. If you're **not well** "DON'T come sailing"
4. Everyone on board **MUST** be a **member** or hold a valid **Sail Pass *prior*** to racing.
5. New prospective members: seek assistance by emailing [committee@jbcyc.com.au](mailto:committee@jbcyc.com.au)
6. Boat **equipped for hygiene**: Soap/water or hand sanitiser, wipes, masks, gloves etc
7. **Email crew** and advise to refer to JBCYC Covid-19 web page.
8. Don't over think it. Talk to Covid-19 Safety Officer or Skipper to **discuss concerns**.
9. **Avoid sharing equipment** where possible. (bottles, winch handles, clothing, etc)
10. Maintain **social distancing where possible**. (No close stacking on the rail).
11. Skipper to **provide guidance & compliance** throughout race.
12. **No unavoidable contact**: (hand-shakes, hugs, high fives etc)
13. **Register for all JBCYC** events electronically (QR code)
14. Vice Commodore will **confirm compliant** boats to starter.
15. **Radio JB 1** on VHF 77 30 mins ***prior*** to start of race to confirm entry.
16. **Race briefings** available the night prior to race on the club web site & on water
17. Advise the Vice Commodore of intended **Protests** ASAP on 0491 094 154
18. **Results will be posted** as soon as possible on the club web site.
19. **Limited shore based gatherings** will occur at the discretion of the committee.
20. **Visitors/boats** looking for crew should contact Vice Commodore: 0491 094 154
21. Skippers should undertake appropriate boat **pre & post-race cleaning**.
22. Race days will be **2 weeks apart** to back up cleaning regime – isolation period
23. No cash payments only **EFT**
24. All procedures apply equally to the club boat **Pandora**
